





Customs corruption


In only 5 files, in the period 2011-2014, National Anticorruption Directorate (DNA) prosecuted 276 customs policemen. In late 2016, Directorate for Investigating Organised Crime and Terrorism (DIICOT) arrested 26 customs policemen at Stamora-Moravita (Serbia boder) for facilitating illegal trade. This is the third large file in Stamora-Moravita after, in two previous operations, 69 and 41 policemen were prosecuted. Practically each year, entire customs structures are sacked while newcomers doing the same illegal actions.


